MEDICATIONS:

- *all medications must be doctor prescribed**
- * must be in pharmacy dispensed MULTI BLISTER PACKAGES**
- *must all have accurate pharmacy labels**
- *all medications must be listed on our application package**
- *do not send unneeded medications (vitamins/treatments/creams)**
- *all medications are administered by health centre staff**
- * provide enough medications for entire stay plus 2 days**
- * only medications which follow the above rules will be administered**
- *camp has own supply of PRN standing order medications**
- *NO EXCEPTIONS MADE TO THE ABOVE RULES**

ARRIVAL TIME: (MONDAY)

**Between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00
a.m.**

- * must arrive at these times**
- *must be brought by an individual who can answer all questions & stay for full registration process**

PICK UP TIME: (FRIDAY)

Between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

- * must check out at health centre prior to leaving camp**
- *will receive fee receipt at this time**
- *a late fee of \$50 per ½ hour per person in effect**

SPECIAL DIETS:

- * must be described in detail on application form**
- * if special food is required, enough for entire stay must be brought on opening day**
- *diabetic diet information must be in detail**

BEHAVIOURS:

- * must be described in detail on application form**
- * protocols must be included with application**
- *PRNs must have administration protocols**

OPENING DAY, PLEASE BRING:

- * photocopy of health card and drug benefit card
 - * all camp paper work filled out
 - * special food required
 - * completed clothing list
- * walk & roll-a-thon sponsor sheet & money
- * spending money for tuck & trips (\$60 per week of stay)
- * all medication in **MULTI BLISTER PACKAGES**

DIRECTIONS:

Located on Third Street off of Wellington # 19 (Garafraxa St.)
*7.8 km from Hwy # 6 (Fergus)
*4 km from Reg. Rd. # 26 (Belwood)

TRANSPORTATION:

You are responsible for making your own transportation arrangements to and from camp.

REASONS FOR BEING SENT HOME:

- * medications do not follow camp rules
- * refusing to take medications
- * medical, behavioural concerns not disclosed fully
- * behavioural concerns that may put others at risk
 - * illness

CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations must be received by mail or phone two weeks prior to arrival for refunds to be considered by the Board of Directors.

VISITORS:

We allow visitors at camp.
Please call ahead to make arrangements with the Director.

DO NOT SEND:

- * any electronics (walk mans, games, etc.)
 - * portable chairs
- * expensive items which can get damaged or lost
 - * instruments/bikes/ garden hoses/ tools
 - * pop/snacks/sweets
 - * aerosol containers
- * all money must be handed in to office during registration

CLOTHING:

- * A clothing list is provided
- * label all items with permanent marker
- * send all items listed including bedding, hygiene supplies, attends, spare glasses, extra shoes and batteries for hearing aids.
 - * do not over pack
- * all items must be listed in detail on clothing list
 - * laundry is done every 3rd day
